Concept Note – Habitat for Humanity Fiji

Habitat for Humanity Fiji (HFH Fiji) builds and repairs homes and sustainable WASH systems for Fijian families in need.

Since 2009, HFH Fiji has provided Shelter and WASH assistance to communities in need and those impacted by disasters through repairs and temporary housing and WASH services.

HFH Fiji believes every Fijian family should have a decent place to live and that the provision of adequate housing and safe water drinking water are fundamental human rights. The dignity that comes with secure housing tenure and water access are the key to breaking the poverty cycle for many low-income and marginalised households. Access to adequate housing and WASH services in the most practical and cost-effective way.

HFH Fiji works with communities to identify their exposure to disaster risk and supports building community resilience through, facilitating training and implementing Housing and WASH infrastructure solutions.

Habitat for Humanity Fiji's vision is, "A Fiji where everyone has a decent place to live".

Anchored by the conviction that housing and WASH provides a path out of poverty, HFH Fiji has assisted more than 37,500 people in Fiji and the Pacific.

HFH Fiji has assisted over 7,800 families through disaster response, assisted over 104 communities with over 15,600 families through water and sanitation improvements and built over 1400 homes in Fiji. HFH Fiji works in all parts of the country. Habitat for Humanity Fiji provides comprehensive project management services, encompassing the entire project lifecycle, from the initial idea and design phase to implementation, commissioning, and handover. By collaborating with the Fiji Government, HFH Fiji ensures that its project objectives are aligned with the needs of the community.

The organisation adopts a people centered approach, focusing on several areas: sector research, community development and infrastructure, policy advocacy, market development, local capacity building, and disaster response projects.

Habitat for Humanity Fiji relies exclusively on grants and funding to carry out its mission of supporting vulnerable communities in need of housing and sanitation facilities. Our corporate building initiative, designed as part of your corporate social responsibility program, presents an opportunity for businesses to contribute to addressing these societal needs in Fiji, where communities in vulnerable situations require assistance.

Habitat for Humanity Fiji regularly receives requests from vulnerable communities throughout Fiji. Due to our limited capacity, we cannot fulfill all these requests. Therefore, we seek to establish partnerships with corporate entities to support these communities or specific villages, offering various options for assistance. These options include funding a home for a family in need, providing support for WASH facilities, contributing to the maintenance and improvement of existing structures, or participating in the funding and construction of new homes for deserving families.



In the past, Habitat for Humanity Fiji has collaborated with corporate organizations such as PWC Fiji, Munro Leys, Sun Rice Australia, and KPMG Fiji, among others, to aid communities in need. Engaging in team-building activities and corporate initiatives aimed at providing families with a place to call home is a deeply rewarding experience for all those involved.
